



**Title: End of Sale for Modular Messaging R1.1 with Exchange.
(REVISED September 28, 2007)**

Notification Date: April 17, 2006

With the General Availability (GA) of Modular Messaging Release 3.0, Avaya will End of Sale software media, licenses, and hardware for Avaya Modular Messaging Release R1.1 with Exchange.

Effective **July 30, 2006** Avaya will no longer allow new quotations or orders for new systems sales of Modular Messaging R1.1 with Exchange, including the offer options for Avaya Servers and Customer Provided Servers.

Note that in a previous End of Sale announcement targeted at sales in the European Union, Modular Messaging R1.1 with Exchange on Avaya Servers was discontinued, effective April 3, 2006, to comply with RoHS regulations.

REVISED: Effective **July 30, 2007** Avaya will no longer allow new quotations or orders for additions and expansions to existing systems of Modular Messaging R1.1 with Exchange that require Avaya Modular Messaging hardware.

REVISED: Effective **July 30, 2007** Avaya will allow seat license additions to existing Modular Message R1.1 with Exchange systems provided additional Avaya hardware is not required to support the addition. Refer to the SAP Codes Available for Aftermarket Expansions/Additions section of this document for details.

SAP Codes Available for Aftermarket Expansions/Additions

Beginning July 30, 2007 the following SAP codes will continue to be available to support aftermarket expansions/additions of seat licenses only, provided additional Avaya hardware is not required. Initially, these SAP material codes will not be available for order via ASD – a manual order is required. ASD enhancements in the next few months will introduce a pick-list capability that will support the simple addition of seats only. Please confirm that sufficient



capacity is available on MM system for the seat licenses requested prior to placing your order. Please engage ATAC if assistance is required in making this determination.

Migration Strategy

In continuing to extend value to Modular Messaging customers, Avaya will offer Modular Messaging R3.0. This release will provide numerous enhancements to Release 1.1 with Exchange, including; multiple time zones, Serenade TUI, SIP Integration to Avaya Communication Manager, and LAN Back-up.

Modular Messaging R1.1 with Exchange systems can be upgraded to Modular Messaging R3.0 directly. Unified Messenger R5 systems will need to upgrade to Modular Messaging R1.1 via PCN 1423B prior to upgrading to Modular Messaging R3.0; there will not be an offer to upgrade from UM R5 to MM R3.0 directly. Please note that PCN 1423B expires June 30, 2006.

Please note that Brooktrout analog port cards supported with Unified Messenger and with Unified Messenger customers who upgraded to Modular Messaging Release 1.1 are not supported with Modular Messaging Release 3.0. Customers that still have these cards in place will need to replace these cards in order to upgrade to Modular Messaging R3.0.
